4. First Aid Measures

10. Stability and Reactivity

----CHRONIC TOXICOLOGY (SUMMARY)----

The base oils in this product are severely solvent refined and/or severely hydro treated. Chronic mouse skin painting studies of severely treated oils showed no evidence of carcinogenic effects. These results are confirmed on a continuing basis using various screening methods such as the Mobil Modified Ames Test and IP-346.

SENSITIZATION (SUMMARY)

Representative formulations have not caused skin sensitization in guinea pigs.

12. Ecological Information

ENVIRONMENTAL FATE AND EFFECTS: This product is expected to be inherently biodegradable. There is no evidence to suggest bioaccumulation will occur. It is not expected to be toxic to aquatic organisms.

Accidental spillage may lead to penetration in the soil and groundwater. However, there is no evidence that this would cause adverse ecological effects.
